
**EXHAUST AND EVAPORATIVE EMISSIONS CONTROL WARRANTY STATEMENT
For the United States, California**

YOUR WARRANTY RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

The California Air Resources Board, the United States Environmental Protection Agency and Worldlawn Power Equipment, Inc, (Worldlawn) are pleased to explain the emission control system warranty on your LC2P77F/LC2P82F. In the United States and California, new equipment that use small engines must be designed, built, and equipped to meet the State's stringent anti-smog standards. Worldlawn must warrant the emission control system for the periods of time listed below provided there has been no abuse, neglect, or improper maintenance leading to the failure of the emissions control system. Where a warrantable condition exists, Worldlawn will repair or replace your engine LC2P77F/LC2P82F at no cost to you including diagnosis, parts, and labor.

MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY COVERAGE

The exhaust and evaporative emissions control system on your engine LC2P77F/LC2P82F is warranted for two years. The warranty period begins on the date the new engine/equipment is purchased by/delivered to its original, end-use purchaser/owner. If any emission related part on your engine LC2P77F/LC2P82F is defective, the part will be repaired or replaced by Worldlawn.

OWNER'S WARRANTY RESPONSIBILITIES:

As the engine/equipment owner, you are responsible to perform the required maintenance listed in your owner's manual. Worldlawn recommends that you retain all receipts covering maintenance on your small engine/equipment, but Worldlawn cannot deny warranty coverage solely for the lack of receipts or for your failure to perform of all scheduled maintenance. As the engine/equipment owner, you should however be aware that Worldlawn may deny you warranty coverage if your engine/equipment or a part has failed due to abuse, neglect, improper maintenance, or unapproved modifications. You are responsible for presenting your engine/equipment to an Worldlawn service center as soon as the problem exists. The warranty repairs shall be completed in a reasonable amount of time, not to exceed 30 days. DEFECT WARRANTY STATEMENT

(a) The emission control system warranty period shall begin on the date the new engine/equipment is purchased by/delivered to its original, end-use purchaser/owner and shall continue for the lesser of:

(1) The warranted period is two years or the duration of The Worldlawn Warranty, whichever is longer, or

(2) For engine or equipment equipped with hour-meter, a number of operating hours equal to half of the engine's useful life. The useful life is specified on the Emissions Control Label on the engine.

(b) General Emissions Warranty Coverage: Worldlawn warrants to the original, end-use purchaser/owner of the new engine or equipment and to each subsequent purchaser/owner that the emissions control system when installed was:

(1) Designed, built, and equipped to conform with all applicable regulations; and

(2) Free from defects in materials and workmanship which cause the failure of a warranted part at any time during the emissions control system warranty period.

(c) The warranty on emissions-related parts will be interpreted as follows:

(1) Any warranted part that is not scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the Owner's Manual shall be warranted for the emission control system warranty period. If any such part fails during the emission control system warranty period, it shall be repaired or replaced by Worldlawn according to Subsection (4) below. Any such part repaired or replaced under the emission control system warranty shall be warranted for the remainder of the emission control system warranty period.

(2) Any warranted part that is scheduled only for regular inspection as specified in the Owner's Manual shall be warranted for the emission control system warranty period. A statement in the Owner's Manual to the effect of "repair or replace as necessary" shall not reduce the emission control system warranty period. Any such part repaired or replaced under the emission control system warranty shall be warranted for the remainder of the emission control system warranty period.

(3) Any warranted part that is scheduled for replacement as required maintenance in the Owner's Manual shall be warranted for, the period of time, prior to first scheduled replacement point for that part. If the part fails prior to the first scheduled replacement, the part shall be repaired or replaced by Worldlawn according to Subsection (4) below. Any such emissions-related part repaired or replaced under the emission control system warranty shall be warranted for the remainder of the period prior to the first scheduled replacement point for that part.

(4) Repair or replacement of any warranted, emissions-related part under this emission control system warranty shall be performed at no charge to the owner at a Worldlawn authorized warranty service facility.

(5) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (4) above, warranty services or repairs must be provided at Worldlawn Authorized Service Facilities.

(6) When the engine is inspected by an Worldlawn authorized warranty service facility, the purchaser/owner shall not be held responsible for diagnostic costs if the repair is deemed warrantable.

(7) Throughout the emission control system warranty period, Worldlawn shall maintain a supply of warranted emission-related parts sufficient to meet the expected demand for such parts.

(8) Any Worldlawn authorized, and approved emission-related replacement parts may be used in the performance of any emission control system warranty maintenance or repairs and will be provided without charge to the purchaser/owner. Such use shall not reduce Worldlawn emission control system warranty obligations.

(9) No modifications, other than those explicitly approved by Worldlawn, may be made to the engine. Unapproved modifications void this emission control system warranty and shall be sufficient ground for

disallowing an emission control system warranty claim.

(10) Worldlawn shall not be held liable hereunder for failures of any non-authorized replacement parts, or failures of any authorized parts caused by, the use of, non-authorized replacement parts.

EMISSION WARRANTY PARTS LISTS

Emission related parts may include the following (if equipped):

1. Fuel System Parts

- Carburetor and internal parts
- Cold starting enrichment (primer or choke)
- Fuel pump
- Fuel line, fittings, and clamps
- Fuel tank, cap, and tether
- Carbon canister

2. Air Induction System

- Air cleaner
- Intake manifold
- Crankcase vent and line(s)
- Purge line and fittings

3. Ignition System

- Spark plug(s) and wire(s)
- Magneto ignition system

4. Catalytic Exhaust System

- Catalytic converter
- Exhaust manifold
- Air injector system and valve(s)

5. Miscellaneous Items Used in Emission Control System

- Valves, switches, and linkages
- Connectors, fittings, and brackets
